






### Telly's featured annual: Cordyline 'Electric Pink'

Cordyline terminalis has been the plant of choice for gardeners seeking the perfect spike alternative. This new one has bright pink stripes through its already beautiful bronze-red leaves.



**Angelonia 'Angelface Deep Violet'** Velvety-purple orchid-like flowers on 18-24" tall plants. No deadheading required. Outstanding in containers.





**Pansy 'Velocity' Series** Touted as the first ever heat tolerant pansy. Available in several colors including shades of blue, yellow, and white.







**Coreopsis 'Full Moon'** Fresh from an 8 year intensive breeding program the Big Bang™ series introduces this new mid-border coreopsis with 3" diameter yellow flowers all summer long. This one will be popular. Height: 24-30".



**Echinacea 'Green Envy'** We had to think twice about featuring yet another coneflower, but this is truly unique. Cone and petals open light green, over several days pink suffuses the petals and the cone darkens to dark brown.

**Echinacea 'Tiki Torch'** This is the best orange coneflower available, with extra wide, overlapping, pumpkin orange petals. Blooms are produced July to September. Height: 30-36".



**Baptisia 'Starlight Prairie-blues'**™ This new hybrid selection joins two of our most beautiful natives. Lupine-like flower spikes of 3-4' bear dozens of light blue flowers with glowing white bases.



**Geranium phaeum 'Spring-time'** Vigorous, easy plant forms mounds of densely packed, white marbled leaves with dark purple spots. Spikes of dark maroon flowers rise up above the foliage for several weeks in mid-spring.



**Heuchera 'Tiramisu'** This new coral bell inherits tolerance of intense heat and humidity from its *H. villosa* parent. Exceptional vigor and winter hardiness. Bright chartreuse leaves have red markings in spring and fall.

**Heuchera 'Pinot Gris'** Leaves start out the color of ginger ale with a light silver overlay and mature to a deep smoky rose while the silvery overlay becomes more prominent. Great colors on heat tolerant, vigorous plants.



**Epimedium 'Fire Dragon'** Popular for their dense clumps of evergreen foliage that thrive in dry shade, these bishop's caps have larger, showier long lasting yellow flowers with purplish bracts. A welcome addition to the shade garden.

**Itoh Hybrid Peonies** In high demand and rare, we will feature a selection of intersectional hybrid peonies. Morning Lilac bears numerous 6" flowers in deep lavender-pink with white and pink stripes and streaks. Don't miss our Itoh Peonies class on Thursday, May 15. See page 18 for more information.



**Sedum 'Autumn Delight'** An offspring of S. Autumn Joy with chartreuse-yellow leaves with narrow blue-green margins. This bright display will pair beautifully with any of the dark, purple foliated sedums.



**Dianthus 'Chomley Farran'** An old-fashioned but rarely seen fully double carnation has striped rose like flowers in hot pink and lavender. Flowers atop 15" mounds of silvery-blue foliage.



**Iris Germanica 'Before the Storm'** The darkest of the dark. This multiple award winning tall bearded iris has large midnight blue flowers blessed with a mild and delightful fragrance.

**Hemerocallis 'French Lingerie'** Mid-season blooming daylily. Lightly fragrant lavender blooms with heavily ruffled yellow-green edges and a yellow eye.



**Phlox 'Watermelon Punch'** Part of the Dwarf Cocktail™ series of garden phlox that all are prolific bloomers on short, stout, mildew resistant plants. This variety has watermelon pink flowers with white eyes.

**Astrantia 'Claret'** Borne on black stems, the "flowers" of this masterwort are really an umbel of dozens of small red florets surrounded by dark, wine red bracts. Attractive palm shaped leaves. A butterfly favorite.



**Heuchera 'Pistache'** Large leaves of vivid pistachio-green seem to have an ethereal glow. (Batteries not needed). Excellent companion for dark leaved shade lovers. Vigorous and hardy in morning sun to moderate shade.



**Bergenia 'Solar Flair'** This pigsqueek has beautiful green and gold variegated leaves from spring until fall. Bergenia foliage persists through the winter when it turns a russet red. Sun or Shade. (Not available until June)



**Fern Athyrium Dre's Dagger** A classic beauty, this lady fern has bright green, crested fronds whose sharp dagger-like leaflets criss-cross for a very unusual look. 12-18" tall.



**Tricyrtus 'Golden Leopard'** Our favorite toad lily. If it didn't have spots it would contradict everything you know about this fine genus. Buttery yellow flowers on tall upright stems in July. Excellent and long lasting cut flower too. 24".



**Helleborus 'Pine Knot'** Strain Pine Knot Farms, breeding Lenten roses since the early '90s, have helped move the plant from obscurity to the shade gardening mainstream. One of the earliest perennials to bloom in the garden. Choose from a multitude of colors. Foliage is semi-evergreen. Height: 15-20".



**Trollius Alabaster** The palest primrose yellow of all globe flowers. In spring the large double blooms of this variety come wonderfully close to white, easily living up to its name. To 24".



# Perennials Grasses & Vines

**Miscanthus 'Bitsy Ben'** A new selection that helps fill the size niche between the tall and short Japanese silver grass. Up to 4'. Silvery purple plumes open in late August above rich green leaves with a white mid-rib.



**Hakonechloa 'Beni-Kazi'** Translates to 'Red Wind'. Forms attractive, thick clumps of red-tipped leaves with a graceful weeping habit. The red intensifies as weather cools in fall.



**Calamagrostis 'Cheju-Do'** Feather reed grass has always been popular for its strongly vertical habit and early opening, long-lasting flowers. This variety, similar to Karl Foerster, bears the same, large flowers on plants that are a foot shorter.

**Perennial Vines** Vines are extremely useful for providing vertical interest in the garden. Take advantage of features such as showy foliage, flowers or berries. Be sure to ask for a vine selection guide during your next visit to Telly's.



**Clematis 'Hendryetta'** Hanging bell shaped flowers of a deep rose-pink with light pink edges are produced in abundance from July to September on this clematis. Use to scramble up and through nearby plants for added color.



**Clematis 'Gravetye Beauty'** A classic but underused clematis. Bears multitudes of fantastic, fire-engine red flowers on current season's growth from July to August.



**Clematis 'Killian Donahue'** An early blooming clematis with large, 5" bi-colored flowers that open up with ruby red centers with orchid edges. An excellent rebloomer through the summer.

# Perennials Groundcovers & Hostas

**Perennial Groundcovers** are valuable for covering larger areas with foliage and flowers. There's a groundcover for nearly every situation... sun to shade and some even tolerate foot traffic. Ask for a groundcover selection guide during your next visit to Telly's.



**Phlox 'Chattahoochee'** A spreading, low growing hybrid phlox produces an abundance of pale lavender flowers in spring. One of several phlox that make excellent groundcover in the woodland garden.



**Sedum hispanicum 'Pinkie'** Wonderful new small scale groundcover for sun. Its metallic gray-blue foliage, to only 2", picks up a rich rosy blush in cooler weather. For rock gardens, stepping stones, troughs or walls.



**Mukdenia 'Karasuba'** Creeping Heuchera relative with large, dark green, fan-shaped leaves with purple-red edges. During summer the color spreads to entire leaf.

**Hosta** are the backbone of the shade garden. Hosta may grow as tall as 48" or as low as an inch and may be used almost anywhere. Some will even tolerate sun. Choose from over 300 varieties. Don't miss the hosta show on June 9th...



**Blue Mouse Ears** Hosta of the Year 2008. A wonderful mini with a great name. Forms perfectly round mounds of thick, rubbery leaves. Ideal hosta for troughs. 8" tall by 12" wide.



**Bix Blues** Did you say you liked blue hostas? Incredibly deep blue leaves have a thick waxy substance on densely mounded plants. 22" tall by 54" wide.



**London Fog Brand** new sport of the interesting and unusual Allegan Fog. Like its parent, the leaves are white decorated with green speckles and streaks throughout, but without the solid green margin. 12" tall by 30" wide.
